What Horizon Managed Services (HMS) users need to know:

As of February 20, 2026, Meta Horizon Managed Services (HMS) is free and remains the required pathway to enroll/activate Meta Quest devices. Meta has also stated HMS will run in maintenance mode until January 4, 2030. After enrollment, day-to-day fleet management is handled through a third-party MDM.

What this means: If you're managing a Quest fleet, you should plan to transition your day-to-day device management to a third-party MDM sooner rather than later. "Maintenance mode" generally indicates no new features and only limited updates over time. To ensure stability, reliable kiosk mode, and timely content updates, a fully-featured MDM is essential.



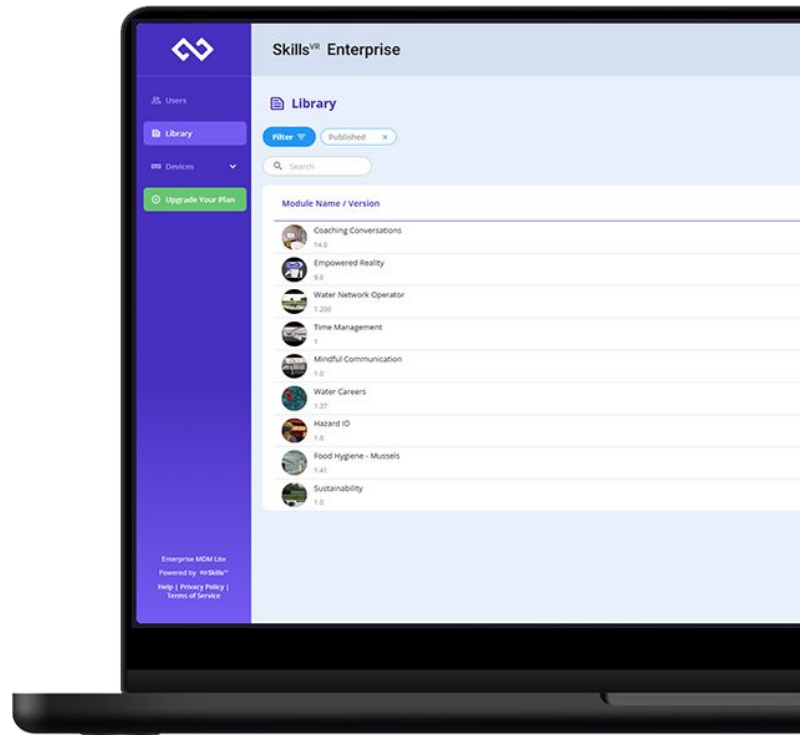
What is **ACTIVATE MDM LITE** ?

ACTIVATE MDM Lite is SkillsVR's free device management tool for VR headsets, the single place you go to keep a fleet set up the same way, updated, secure, and ready for training, without touching every headset one by one.

Currently, HMS is still used to enroll Quest devices – after that, you need a third-party MDM for day-to-day management, and that's where **ACTIVATE MDM Lite** comes in.

ACTIVATE MDM Lite helps you:

- Get headsets ready faster (less setup before each rollout)
- Reduce day-to-day admin (fewer manual fixes and repeat tasks)
- Keep training consistent across sites and sessions
- Avoid last-minute issues (updates and settings are controlled)
- See what's going on across your fleet (which headsets are ready, offline, or need attention)



What you can do in **ACTIVATE MDM LITE**

After switching, you can manage your Quest fleet from one place:

- **Send apps and training content** to headsets
- **Set up Wi-Fi remotely** (so devices work on arrival)
- **Keep device settings consistent** across your fleet
- **Control firmware updates** (so nothing breaks before training)
- **Check device status** across sites (and location where enabled)
- **Control who can do what** with admin roles and permissions





How to switch | Step-by-step

Step 1:

Register

- Register your organization (takes minutes)
- No credit card required
- Your six months free starts when you activate

Step 2:

Enroll devices via HMS

- In your Meta admin setup, follow the standard HMS enrollment process
- Confirm your Quest headsets are successfully enrolled

Step 3:

Connect Skills^{VR}

- In HMS, select SkillsVR as your device management partner (MDM)
- Once connected, devices can be managed day-to-day in ACTIVATE MDM Lite

Step 4:

Setup & deploy

- Create a simple standard for your headsets: Install apps, Configure Wifi, Device settings, Choose rules
- Push the right content to the right headsets
- Manage in ACTIVATE MDM LITE

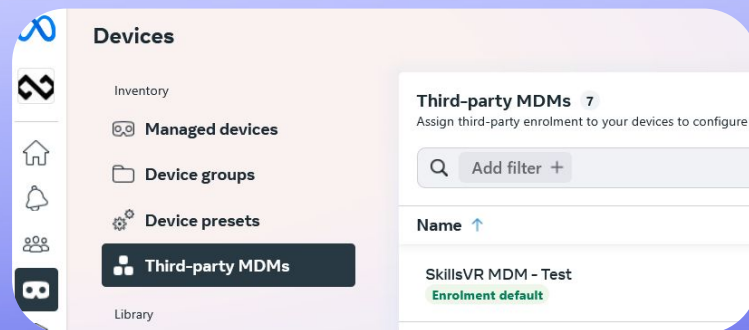
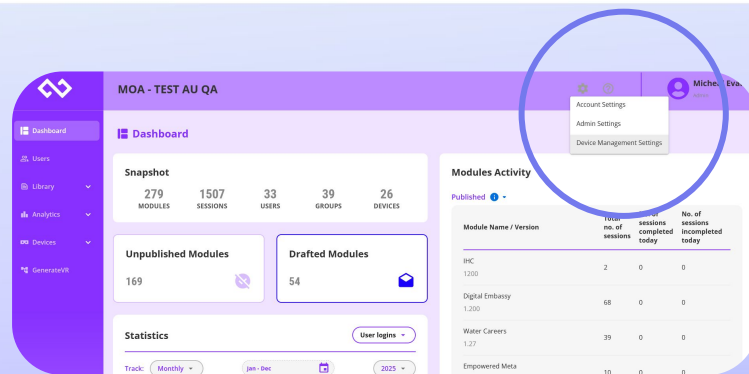

Step 1: Prepare Your Skills^{VR} Enrollment Token

- In your Skills^{VR} organization's Device Management Settings, enable the option for Quest devices.
- Download the Organization Enrollment Token and save it securely for later use.

Step 2: Access Meta Admin Center

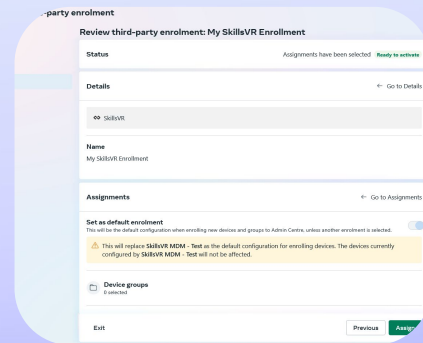
- Log in to your Meta Admin Center account.
- Navigate to the Devices page.
- Select "Third-party MDMs."

Step 3: Create Third-Party Enrollment

- Click "Create third-party enrollment" to start.
- Choose Skills^{VR} as your enrollment provider and name your enrollment.
- Upload the Skills^{VR} enrollment token, then click "Next."
- Set this as the default enrollment if desired, review your configuration, and click "Assign".

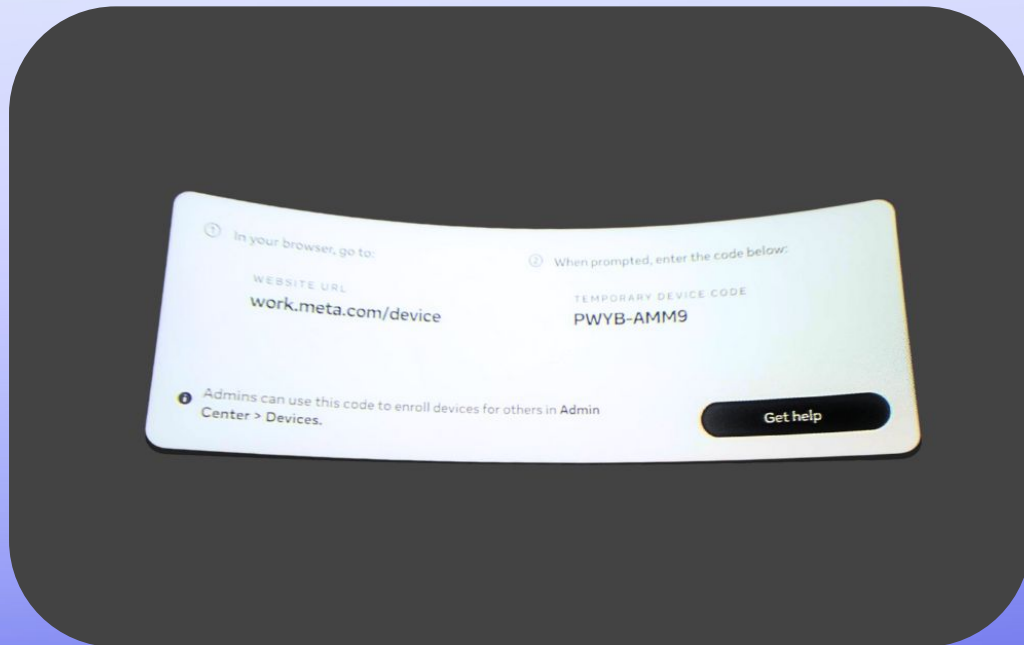

Step 4: Begin Headset Setup

- Start the out-of-box setup on your Quest device.
- After updates and restart, select "Connect to your organization" when prompted.
- Note the activation code displayed on the headset screen.

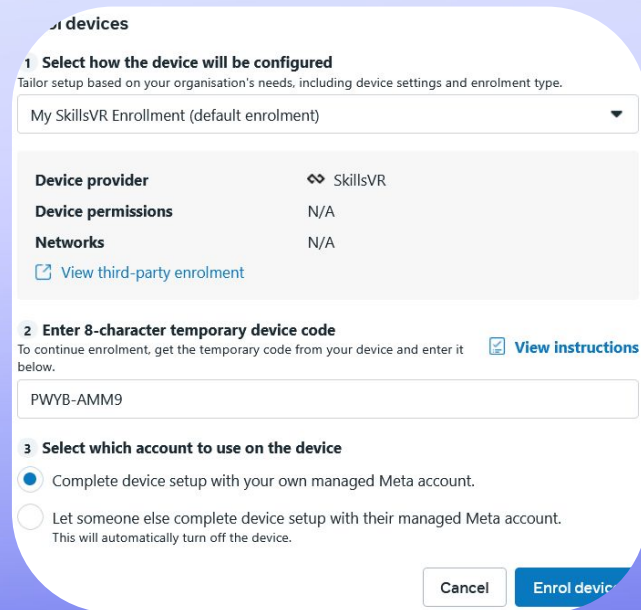
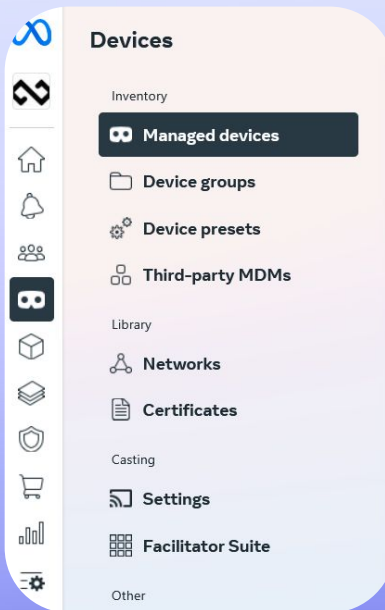

Step 5: Enroll Device in Meta Admin Center

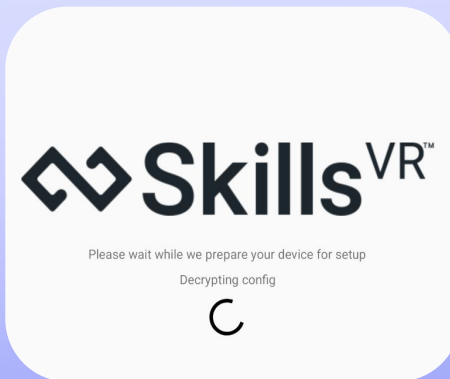
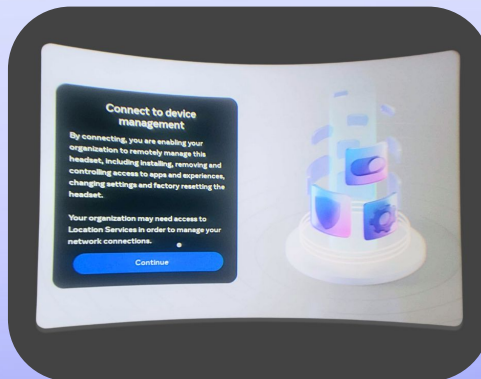
- In Meta Admin Center, go to Devices > Managed Devices and click "Enroll devices."
- Select your SkillsVR enrollment from the dropdown (it may be under "Third-party enrollments").
- Enter the activation code from your headset and confirm enrollment.

Step 6: Finalize Setup on Headset

- Return to your device and complete the Meta setup screens.
- Proceed through the Skills^{VR} setup screens (no input required).
- Once the device reboots, it is ready for use with Skills^{VR} and Meta Horizon Managed Services.
